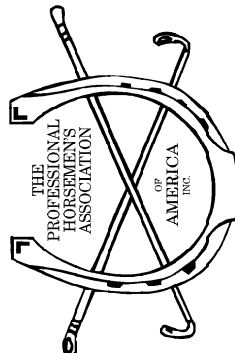

There is a 5% surcharge for using a credit card. Credit cards will be charged when entries are received.

The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show.

All prize money will be paid by check in the show office or mailed to winners.

There will be a \$50 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank or credit cards that are denied.

After the closing date there will be NO REFUNDS on entries unless your position is filled by another horse. \$25.00 Charge for All Scratched Horses. No Refunds On Stalls

The show manager and management take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.

Every horse will be charged a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance fee per rider and a \$25 Office Fee.

All Dogs Must Be Restrained At All Times.

Medal Classes: The initial test will be built into the course. Further testing at the discretion of the judges. All courses will consist of at least 8 jumping efforts at the stated height.

Hunter Classes: All classes will be judged on an open numerical scoring system. All courses will consist of at least 8 jumping efforts at the stated height.

Horses will be permitted to hack in the show arena each morning and from 5PM-7PM Thursday evening, but all schooling will be in an indoor schooling arena and/or outdoor ring, weather permitting.

If there are less than 5 entries in Long or Short Stirrup the divisions will be combined.

If there are less than 4 entries in the Sm/Med or Large Pony the divisions will be combined.

Coggins Test within within the year for out of state horses and since 10/28/2021 for NYS Horses.
